HENDERSON AREA RAPID TRANSIT (HART)

Henderson Community College is served on weekdays by the Henderson Area Rapid Transit (HART). The van will leave downtown Henderson (corner of Main and Third Streets) at 7:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., and 3:30 p.m. daily. The van will arrive at HCC at approximately 40 minutes after the hour and depart immediately after unloading. The van will return directly to Third and Main Streets. Fare is .50 each way.
